### CONDITIONS

#### **Definitions**

Motor Vehicle is defined in section 4 of the Road Traffic (Administration) Act 2008.

- The Authorised Person must only allow the Premises to be used for examining the following vehicle types: Light Vehicles (Motor Vehicles with Gross Vehicle Mass not exceeding 4,500kg).
- 2. The Authorised Person must only allow the Premises to be used for the examinations noted in Annexure A unless prior written authorisation has been granted by the CEO.
- **3.** Vehicle examinations not included in this agreement:
  - first inspection of personally imported vehicles;
  - any vehicle, the examination of which is likely to involve a conflict of interest.

- 4. The Authorised Person must comply with any reasonable directions made by the CEO in relation to examining and testing of vehicles at the Premises. Directions given by the CEO must be in writing and addressed to the Authorised Person.
- 5. The Authorised Vehicle Examiner (AVE) must not allow a person to examine and test vehicles at the Premises unless that person holds an authorisation to examine and test vehicles. The Authorised Person must ensure this Authorisation is displayed at the Premises.
- 6. The AVE must comply with any operating manual/rules in relation to the examination and testing of vehicles, as approved by the Executive Director Driver and Vehicle Services, Department of Transport.
- Any previous Authorised Inspection Station Certificate of Authorisation is no longer valid.

#### **ANNEXURE A**

The Authorised person must only allow the Premises to be used for the examinations noted below:

- · vehicles issued with a defect notice (work order);
- new vehicles (not previously licensed);
- certain vehicles transferring registration from other Australian states, The Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory;
- vehicles that have previously been licensed but the WA licence has lapsed by over three months;
- vehicles requiring minor correction of their licence details;
- A, B and C Class vehicles in terms of regulation 33 of the Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014;
- vehicles that require an annual examination such as passenger transport vehicles, omnibuses, driving school vehicles and street rods;

- vehicles that have been repaired and examined by an Approved Written-Off Vehicle examiner after being registered on the Written-Off Vehicle Register;
- certain second hand vehicles that have been imported and not previously been registered in Australia supported by the Australian Design Rules Compliance Report and Federal Government Import Approval;
- kit cars, street rods, dedicated rally cars or individually constructed vehicles supported by the Vehicle Safety & Standards Branch approval;
- vehicles requiring re-examination after failing any of the above inspections; or
- any other examinations authorised in writing by the CEO.
